

INTRODUCTION

This report covers a 3 weeks trip to Uganda, by my non-birding partner Liza Pogoy and David Van den Schoor. It was my first visit to the country, so there were many lifers for me to see but the focus was especially on restricted-range species in the Albertine Rift Mountains and much-wanted species like Shoebill and Green-breasted Pitta. To make it not too hard for Liza, I spend limited time on nocturnal species. I managed to see (or hear) 576 species, following strictly taxonomy, names and sequence of James F. Clements 6th edition. I'm not going to write a true 'trip report', as good site descriptions have been made in 'Where to Watch Birds in Uganda' and in several reports (see references).

GEOGRAPHY

Uganda is a landlocked country astride the equator, about 800 kilometres inland from the Indian Ocean. It lies on the north-western shores of Lake Victoria, extending from 1 south to 4 north latitude and 30 to 35 east longitude.

Land Use:

In the southern half of the country, rich soil and rainfall permit extensive agriculture, and in the drier and less fertile northern areas, pastoral economies are common. Approximately 21 percent of the land is cultivated and 45 percent is woodland and grassland, some of which has been cleared for roads, settlements, and farmland in the south. Approximately 13 percent of the land is set aside as national parks, forests, and game reserves. Swampland surrounding lakes in the southern and central regions supports abundant papyrus growth. The central region's woodlands and savanna give way to acacia and cactus growth in the north. Valuable seams of copper, cobalt, and other minerals have been revealed along geological fault lines in the southeast and southwest. Volcanic foothills in the east contain phosphates and limestone.

Mountains:

Southern Uganda lies at an altitude of 1130 meters above sea level. The plateau that stretches northward from Lake Victoria declines gradually to an altitude of 914 meters on the Sudan border. The gradually sloping terrain is interrupted by a shallow basin dipping toward the center of the country and small areas of tropical forest, which mark the western border with Zaire.

Both eastern and western borders are marked by mountains. The Ruwenzori Mountains (often called Albertine Rift Mountains or the Mountains of the Moon) form about eighty kilometres of the border between Uganda and Zaire. The highest peaks of Mount Stanley, in the Ruwenzori's, are snow capped. Foremost among these are Margherita (5113 meters) and Alexandra (5094 meters). Farther south, the northernmost of the Mufumbiro volcanoes reach 4132 meters on Mount Mahavura; 3648 meters on Mount Mgahinga; and 3477 meters on Mount Sabinio, which marks the border with Rwanda and Zaire.

In eastern Uganda, the border with Kenya is also marked by volcanic hills. Dominating these, roughly 120 kilometres north of the equator, is Mount Elgon, which rises from the 1200-meter plains to reach a height of 4324 meters. Mount Elgon is the cone of an extinct volcano, with ridges radiating thirty kilometres from its crater. Rich soil from its slopes is eroded into the plains below. North of Mount Elgon are Kadam (also known as Debasien or Tabasiat) Peak, which reaches a height of 3054 meters, and Mount Moroto, at 3085 meters. In the far northeast, Mount Zulia, Mount Morungole, and the Labwor and Dodoth Hills reach heights in excess of 2000 meters. The lower Imatong Mountains and Mount Langia, at 3029 meters, mark the border with Sudan.

Lakes and Rivers:

Uganda is a well-watered country. Nearly one-fifth of the total area, or 44,000 square kilometres, is open water or swampland. Four of East Africa's Great Lakes--Lake Victoria, Lake Kyoga, Lake Albert, and Lake Edward--lie within Uganda or on its borders. Lake Victoria dominates the south-eastern corner of the nation, with almost one-half of its 10,200 square kilometres area lying inside Ugandan territory. It is the second largest inland freshwater lake in the world (after Lake Superior), and it feeds the upper waters of the Nile River, which is referred to in this region as the Victoria Nile.

Lake Kyoga and the surrounding basin dominate central Uganda. Extensions of Lake Kyoga include Lake Kwanaia, Lake Bugondo, and Lake Opeta. These "finger lakes" are surrounded by swampland during rainy seasons. All lakes in the Lake Kyoga Basin are shallow, usually reaching a depth of only eight or nine meters, and Lake Opeta forms a separate lake during dry seasons. Along the border with Zaire, Lake Albert, Lake Edward, and Lake George occupy troughs in the western Rift Valley.

Leaving Lake Victoria at Owen Falls, the Victoria Nile descends as it travels toward the northwest. Widening to form Lake Kyoga, the Nile receives the Kafu River from the west before flowing north to Lake Albert. From Lake Albert, the Nile is known as the Albert Nile as it travels roughly 200 kilometres to the Sudan border. In southern and western Uganda, geological activity over several centuries has shifted drainage patterns. The land west of Lake Victoria is traversed by valleys that were once rivers

carrying the waters of Lake Victoria into the Congo River system. The Katonga River flows westward from Lake Victoria to Lake George. Lake George and Lake Edward are connected by the Kizinga Channel. The Semliki River flows into Lake Edward from the north, where it drains parts of Zaire and forms a portion of the Uganda-Zaire border.

Spectacular waterfalls occur at Murchison (Kabalega) Falls on the Victoria Nile River just east of Lake Albert. At the narrowest point on the falls, the waters of the Nile pass through an opening barely seven meters wide. One of the tributaries of the Albert Nile, the Zoka River, drains the north-western corner of Uganda, a region still popularly known as the West Nile although that name was not officially recognized in 1989. Other major rivers include the Achwa River (called the Aswa in Sudan) in the north, the Pager River and the Dopeth-Okok River in the northeast, and the Mpologoma River, which drains into Lake Kyoga from the southeast.

FLIGHT AND VISA

We flew from Brussels to Entebbe via Cairo with Egyptair for 816,00 EUR return pp, taxes included. Immigration officials will stamp 90 days in your passport when you enter. The cost for this single-entry is 50 US Dollar. If you want to stay longer than 3 months you will have to get an extension or obtain a visa. The cost for a multiple-entry (6 months) is 100 US Dollar or 200 US Dollar (12 months).

Tourist visas are extended on the last valid day. You should keep the immigration paper given to you on arrival in a safe place as you will need to show this upon departure. I recommend that your passport should have a remaining validity of at least six months. To learn more about visas, check with your consulate or your embassy in Uganda for details pertaining to your citizenship. Uganda requires a valid passport from all travellers, as well as proof of return to your home country or onward journey, though this is rarely checked. At this time no yellow fever vaccination is required. Another option is to arrange your visa in advance at the embassy like we did. We paid 38,00 EUR per person. Bring your passport, 1 passport photo, a copy of your booking and cash money. You have to fill in the application on the spot. You can pick-up your passport already the next day.

MONEY

The unit of currency in Uganda is the Uganda Shilling (UGX). Notes are in denominations of UGX 50000, 20000, 10000, 5000 and 1000. Coins are in denominations of UGX 500, 200 and 100. The exchange rate at the Entebbe airport during our stay was 1600 UGX to the US Dollar. You can also use ATM machines in large towns and cities if banks are closed. Credit cards were only accepted in our hotel in Kampala and they charge then an additional 5% commission! Very important to know is that US Dollar bills must be more recent than 2000! Bank notes from 1999 or older were only accepted in some banks and the exchange rate fluctuated then between 1500 and even 1300 UGX to the US Dollar. In the National parks where the entrance fee mostly is given in US Dollars they only accept recent bills. If you want to pay here in Ugandan Shillings they using a much higher rate (1630 UGX in July and 1670 UGX in August). So, because the unreasonably practices that many organizations using, it is a good idea to discuss and arrange a few things in advance with your local agency.

TOUR SERVICE

By far the best way to see the specialities is to hire a guide or driver. We made our arrangements with Avian Watch Uganda Ltd. The arrangements were made for the whole period and cost 170 US Dollar per day for both of us. It includes a driver, transport with a 4WD Toyota minibus (120 US Dollar per day), and a bird guide (an additional 50 US Dollar per day). Their accommodations and food was included in this price. AWU booked also our accommodations and we had to paid these on sites. Other expenses that we had to pay on the trip were the followings: Park entrance fees, fuel, boat fees and vehicle entrance fees in Murchison, Queen Elizabeth and Lake Mburo National parks. Petrol fluctuated between 2500 UGX (Kampala area) and 2830 UGX (Masindi) per litre. It was really value for money, we saw most of our target birds and we had a lot of fun. Alfred Twinomujuni, the Managing Director of AWU was already booked by another group during our period but Robert Byarugaba, the replacement guide was excellent too.

Robert is a freelance guide who lives in the village near Bwindi Impenetrable Forest NP. Robert is 32 years old, speaks English fluently, is very friendly and is really fantastic in all visited rainforest parks where he knows almost all the birds by call. I can really recommend him!

Our driver was Gideon Kwehangana, a 30 years old freelance safari guide. Gideon lives in the same village as Robert but stayed most of his time in Kampala where there is more business to do. He is not only an excellent driver, he speaks perfect English and is very friendly and helpful. He is not a birder but even more important is that he know all the key spots very well (including some roadside spots like for Marsh Widowbird, Dusky Twinspot, etc.). He and Robert are an excellent team!

The resident man in charge of the AWU office in Kampala is Emmanuel Bisamaza. After my first contact with Alfred, Emmanuel replied all my email requests punctual and quickly. It was a pleasure to communicate with people who actually understood the needs of a birder. Emmanuel's service was one of the best I ever had on a birding trip! He communicated almost daily with Robert or Gideon to be sure that everything developed according to our planning. He even came over from Kampala to Bwindi to help us when we had problems to change our older US Dollar bills. Emmanuel gave us also a fair discount for our overnight stays in the very expensive Hippo hill camp instead of the Institute of ecology guest house where we had a reservation but for some reason no room vacant.

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ELECTRICITY

Note that access to electricity (220 Volt, UK-style plug) is not at all guaranteed in Uganda, especially outside the larger cities. Often there are no power lines, so lodges or hotels need to have a generator in order to produce their own power. Usually they only switch the generator on for a few hours in the evening.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Travellers need to be particularly cautious with respect to what they eat and drink and to insect bites. Hepatitis A and Typhoid Fever are the two most common diseases transmitted through food and water. Yellow Fever and Malaria are the most common diseases transmitted by insects. www.1cover.co.uk/countries.html health section provides an overview of these and other medical considerations for those travelling in Uganda. Health is always an issue of concern for people travelling abroad. Most travellers stay healthy throughout their journeys and return home as fit as ever. You have little to worry about if you educate yourself and take sensible precautions. Uganda is considered one of the safer countries in Africa, though its recent economic woes have caused crime to increase significantly. Uganda's urban centres, especially Kampala is like any large city in the world, generally more dangerous than the countryside.

FOOD AND DRINK

In most towns you will find a good variety of restaurants, supermarkets and food-stalls. Meals are good, generally fine and inexpensive. For those on a budget, the best way to stretch your money is to take advantage of set plate meals. We paid for lunch mostly around 7000 UGX plus drinks per person, for dinner was the price around 10000 UGX plus drinks. Vegetarian meals are mostly available upon request. At only pennies per bite, bakeries offer a delicious range of breads, sweet pastries, and savoury snacks. Dishes sold in the street are also quite cheap, but hygiene is often questionable, and

you may quickly surpass your intestinal limits. A good rule to follow is the "locals rule" -- if the place is frequented by many locals, the food probably merits joining the crowd. For the sake of your intestinal happiness, drink only bottled or boiled water, not water from the tap. Distilled and sparkling waters are available throughout the country and are of good quality. Remember that tap water is frequently used in ice, so request your beverages without ice in restaurants.

LANGUAGE

English is the official language of Uganda, even though only a relatively small percentage of the population speaks it. The East African lingua franca Swahili is relatively widespread as a trade language and was made an official national language of Uganda in September 2005. Luganda, a language widespread in central Uganda, has been the official vernacular language in education for central Uganda for a long time.

CLIMATE AND WEATHER

Uganda's equatorial climate provides plentiful sunshine, moderated by the relatively high altitude of most areas of the country. Mean annual temperatures range from about 16° C in the south-western highlands to 25° C in the northwest; but in the northeast, temperatures exceed 30° C about 250 days per year. Daytime temperatures average about eight to ten degrees warmer than night time temperatures in the Lake Victoria region, and temperatures are generally about fourteen degrees lower in the southwest. Except in the north-eastern corner of the country, rainfall is well distributed. The southern region has two rainy seasons, usually beginning in early April and again in October. Little rain falls in June and December. In the north, occasional rains occur between April and October, while the period from November to March is often very dry. Mean annual rainfall near Lake Victoria often exceeds 2,100 millimetres, and the mountainous regions of the southeast and southwest receive more than 1,500 millimetres of rainfall yearly. The lowest mean annual rainfall in the northeast measures about 500 millimetres.

The weather was quite good during our stay, with temperatures varying from cool and pleasant at night in the mountains to hot in the lower regions. It did rain a little bit on most days late afternoon, especially in the western mountain region, but not much time was lost to heavy rain. Birding was probably the better for the rain as some reports mention low activity due to dry conditions at this time of year.

TIME ZONE

CET Time plus 2 hours during our winter time and plus 1 hour during our summer time.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodations were arranged by Avian Watch Uganda Ltd. and were in general very clean and good. Where necessary there was mostly a fan (lowlands) and hot showers or hot water available (mountains) in the rooms. We stayed at following places:

Lake Mburo NP:	Rwonyo Rest Camp (30000 UGX for a hut/night)
Kisoro:	Kisoro Tourist Hotel (100000 UGX for a double room/night, incl. breakfast)
Ruhisha:	Institute Guest House (20000 UGX for a double room)
Buhoma:	Bwindi View Bandas (45000 UGX for a double room/night)
Queen Elisabeth NP:	Hippo Hill Camp (180 USD for a tent banda, full board)
Semliki NP:	Hotel Vanilla (30000 UGX for a double room/night, incl. breakfast)
Kibale NP:	Chimpanzee Forest Guest House & camp site (120000 UGX for a banda/night incl. breakfast)
Masindi:	Hotel Victory Bijja (55000 UGX for a double room/night, incl. breakfast)
Murchison Falls NP:	Red Chili Rest Camp (50000 UGX for a banda/night)
Kampala:	Holiday Express Hotel (65 USD for a double room/night)

Notes: The Institute of Ecology Guest House which was no available cost 60000 UGX for a double room/night incl. breakfast and is situated inside the park.

The Hippo Hill Camp is outside the park and is much to expensive for their services, absolutely no worth to stay!

Good to know for visiting Mabira Forest is that there is a good alternative to stay for birders opposite the entrance road to the Forest center HQ, for details see www.littlekingston.com . Fried, the Belgian owner runs the guest house now 4 years together with his wife Leila. Nice place and better to stay than in Kampala or Jinja I guess. The price is only 20000 UGX for a double room/night, incl. breakfast.

ENTRANCE FEE

Don't change all your money by arrival if you bring cash US Dollars to Uganda. The entrance fees in the National Parks are given standard in US Dollars. Of course, you can pay in Ugandan Shilling but expect than an exchange rate much to high (see money)!

ITINERARY

- 25/07:** Flight Amsterdam – Cairo. Arrival at 21:30. Transfer to Pharaoh Egypt Hotel.
- 26/07:** Sightseeing in Cairo all day, including a visit to the pyramids of Khufu at Giza. Evening flight Cairo – Entebbe.
- 27/07:** Arrival in Entebbe 03:45. After collecting the luggage, we met our guide and driver in the airport and drove first to a hotel in Entebbe for taking a shower and changing our clothes. Later on, we set off for a hand-peddled boat trip in the Mabamba swamp. Around noon, we start driving to Lake Mburo NP where we made a evening game drive in the park. Night at Rwonyo Rest Camp.
- 28/07:** Another game drive and a short boat trip on the lake. After this, we start our long journey to Kisoro with a birding stop at Echuya Forest en route. Early evening, we checked in for a 2 night stay at Kisoro Tourist Hotel.
- 29/07:** Birding along the Gorge trail at Mgahinga Gorilla NP till half afternoon. Later on, we must cancelled our planned visit to Lake Kyahafi due the extreme heavy storm for the rest of the day.
- 30/07:** Start early for the Ruhizha sector of Bwindi Impenetrable Forest NP with stops at Echuya Forest, Lake Bunyoni and Rubanda swamp en route. Afternoon birding in the bamboo zone along the main track towards the Institute Guest House and along the trail to the school. After dinner out for Owls and Nightjars but not successful. We slept 2 nights in the guest house.
- 31/07:** Full day birding along the Mubwindi swamp trail.
- 01/08:** Again down for a half day along the very steep trail to the Mubwindi swamp. Afternoon transfer to Buhoma with a birding stop at 'The Neck' (another sector of Bwindi Impenetrable Forest NP). We arrived late afternoon for a 4 night stay at the Bwindi View Bandas. Rain for the rest of the evening.
- 02/08:** Full day birding at Bwindi Impenetrable Forest NP (Buhoma main trail and loop trail).
- 03/08:** Again birding at Bwindi Impenetrable Forest NP along the Buhoma main trail and a visit to a small forest patch and a nearby farm later afternoon.
- 04/08:** The same birding as previous day, only we visited another marsh late afternoon.
- 05/08:** Transfer to Queen Elisabeth NP via the Ishasha sector where we started with a game drive. Later on, we set course for Mweya the northern sector of the park. After we heard that our booking at the Institute of Ecology Guest House was cancelled for an unclear reason, we drove as soon as possible outside the park. In that time, Emmanuel had already the Hippo Hill Camp arranged for us.
- 06/08:** We start early for a game drive till noon. After a break early afternoon we made a cruise on the Kazinga channel and another game drive and went out till dinner for owling.
- 07/08:** We spent the first few hours again birding in the Mweya sector of Queen Elisabeth NP and set off then for Semliki NP with a few birding stops and a lunch stop at Fort Portal. Late afternoon we visited the hot springs Sempapa loop near the Semliki Bandas. Just before dinner, we checked in some 30 kilometres further on for a 2 night stay at Hotel Vanilla.
- 08/08:** Full day birding along the Kirumiya trail of Semliki NP.
- 09/08:** We spent another half day along the Kirumiya trail and drove then back to Fort Portal where we had again lunch in The Gardens Restaurant. From here it was only a half hour driving or so to Kibale NP. After dropping our luggage in the Chimpanzee Forest Guest House we drove to

the HQ and made already our booking with a local guide to bring us tomorrow morning early enough to the Pitta site!

- 10/08:** D-day! We met Francis at 6:45 near the Kibale HQ and start walking straight to the area where he saw the Green-breasted Pitta's the last few weeks infrequently. It took us less than 2 hours to find a pair in the open for several minutes. The birds were not shy at all and moved in a circle around us. After perfect views for a few minutes we left the place because the behaviour of the birds told me that we must be very close to the nest site. Probably unnecessarily to say but this was the absolutely highlight of the trip! Satisfied, I spent the afternoon relaxed birding around the lodge with Liza. At 17:00 we visited the nearby Bigodi wetlands. This place is very busy the last few years and no longer a visit worth in my opinion.
- 11/08:** Today was the longest journey of the trip on our program. We start early for the 9 hours non-stop drive to Murchison Falls NP. A few birding stops en route were planned, the most interesting was at the Butiaba escarpment where we scored the most targets. So, we arrived quite late at the Red Chili Rest Camp for a 2 night stay.
- 12/08:** We took the 7:00 ferry and went on a game drive on the northern bank of the Nile till early afternoon. I cancelled the boat trip to the bottom of the falls because nothing important to see for me. We used this time for birding around the camp site and some roadside birding south of the Nile. After dinner, we drove to the airstrip and scored all the needed Nightjars.
- 13/08:** We start again roadside birding south of the Nile and drove towards the top of the falls. Quite impressive and one of the highlights for Liza! Then we set course for Budongo with a 30 minutes stop at Kanyio Pabidi. We were a little bit late for the Puvel's Illadopsis which is quite easily seen early morning around the car park. I didn't make any further effort for this species because I already booked a 10 days 'Picathartes trip' to Ghana next March with friends where this species is also occur. After lunch and checking-in at Hotel Victory Bijja in Masindi for another 2 nights, we drove to Busingiro and met Francis our local guide for the Royal Mile tomorrow. Raymond wanted to enjoy us this afternoon too and he brought us straight to a big tree only a few hundred meters away from the Budongo HQ where Ituri Batis was seen a few times the last week. It took us just 1 minute to tape-in the bird! What a good decision to cancel Kanyio Pabidi.... We spent the rest of the afternoon birding along this roadside forest and in the scrubby area around Nyabyeya Forestry Guest House.
- 14/08:** We birded the famous Royal Mile till half afternoon today and saw all the reasonably species I think. We returned then to the Nyabyeya Forestry Guest House area where we finally scored with White-crested Turaco (of course, later on we will see a few more...). We drove then to a pond for Shining-Blue Kingfisher and were here also successful after one hour waiting. The last hours were spending again at the roadside forest at Busingiro and just like yesterday we approximated Nahan's Francolin less than 10 meters. But again, the bird came never into view! Anyway, surely one of the better days this trip.
- 15/08:** We drove back to Kampala today and saw our only target, the March Widowbird, almost immediately after playback at the Luwero Swamp. We had lunch in Kampala and did not much anymore that afternoon. We stayed our last 2 nights in Holiday Express Hotel.
- 16/08:** Liza stayed today in Kampala and I set off early for my last birding day to Mabira Forest. I ended this very successful trip with 3 lifers today, 2 of them Mabira specialities.
- 17/08:** Flight Entebbe – Cairo and onwards to Amsterdam. Arrival at 15:00.
- Note:** The itinerary was good prepared but the day I lost in Egypt was the day I just needed to make the day trip to Lake Bisina for Uganda's only endemic bird, Fox Weaver.
Good to know for birders departing early evening is that there are 5 free showers at the male Toilet unit, in the departures area. Do, however, bring your own shampoo and towel.
